Description

Worked direct from the Cathedral.

The works involved:

- Recorded and lifted a mosaic floor, which has been stored for future use elsewhere in the Cathedral.
- New floor laid in Purbeck Grub, Rosso Verona and Bonfield Whetson stones.
- Contract completed in close proximity to the public demanded an elaborately hoarded area.
- Bespoke dust extraction plant used to maintain the micro-environment.
